#### **Day 04 Rovaniemi –**

After the breakfast at the hotel Explore the Wilderness Tour

The Wilderness tour is just over 3 hours long, we start by picking you up from your accommodation and then driving you north to start the tour, depending on the difficulty of the tour you would like your guide will take you to one of 3 locations. Each location has something special about it, whether it be whitewater rivers covered in spectacular ice or breathtaking views.

You will have your own private guide and the group will never exceed 8 people. During the tour, you will learn from the fauna and flora, how to make fire from what you find in the forest, even if it is -40, and you will have to experience it yourself. Each tour includes snacks and hot drinks that you will prepare over an open fire.

**Stop At:** Wild About Lapland, Kansankatu 14, Rovaniemi 96100 Finland This is where we meet, for those of you who do not need pick-up. In our Safari Office, you will have the opportunity to dress with some winter overalls and winter boots if you need to.

Duration: 10 minutes

**Stop At:** Lapland, Lapland Experience the Wild Taiga forest and what the Lapland wilderness has best to offer. On this tour, you will feel the peace of the arctic nature, hike through the snowy forests, keep an eye for local wildlife and learn about our surroundings.

The tour begins with your personal guide picking you up from your accommodation and dressing you with overalls and winter boots if conditions require so. You then drive 30 Kilometres north, into the Arctic nature.

Once you arrive at the start, you will be given a brief on what to look out for. The Wilderness Tour has different levels of difficulty depending on your ability, your guide will discuss this with you upon pick up and between you, the best route will be decided.

The Wilderness Tour is a very special opportunity to those who wish to wander into the forest to try and get a glimpse of the spectacular and elusive Finnish wildlife and natural beauty of Lapland. Before heading through the woods you will be taught how to move quietly in the wilderness.

In the winter time, you will enjoy views of huge snow drifts, white trails and frozen trees. You will learn about the footprints you find around you in the snow. It's a shame the Bears will be sleeping as they have a very impressive paw print! But not to worry as we still have the chance of passing tracks made by Wolves, Lynx, Wolverines, Moose, Reindeer, Weasles, Arctic hare and many more.

During the summer your guide will teach you about the nature that surrounds you. The aim

of this tour is to show you wild and beautiful forests that look as if they are straight out of a fairytale. We will help you to learn the best secrets of how to appreciate these places. During every tour, your guide will show you how to build and light a fire without the use of matches. You will learn what to look for in the forests that allow you to make fire easily at any time without damaging any vegetation. This tour is a great opportunity for those of you who are photo enthusiasts!

**Duration: 2 hours**

### **Day 06- Rovaniemi to Helsinki –**

After breakfast at the hotel let's move towards Helsinki. After check in at the hotel explore Helsinki Sightseeing with Seurasaari Open-Air Museum Day Tour, Helsinki Visit Helsinki's most famous sites, then continue to Seurasaari Open-Air Museum, located on an island outside the city center. Learn about the traditional Finnish way of life from 18th to 20th

through a tour of the museum's manors and farmsteads. Begin your 5-hours tour around 10am after pickup from the designated hotel meeting points in Helsinki. The designed meeting points are close to many hotels and apartments with walking distance.

First, we visit the city's cultural landmarks and historic monuments, including: Olympic Stadium, Sibelius Monument, Esplanade Park, Market square, Uspenski Orthodox Cathedral, and Senate Square.

After this city tour, we continue to the Seurasaari Open-Air Museum for a guided tour of the island. Starting with a lunch break on Seurasaari island, where there was a restaurant built in 1890 and a cafe where serves 18 different flavors of ice cream. The open-air museum is dotted with wooden buildings, which once belonged to farmers and villagers from all around Finland, and as you explore the rural villages, you'll gain a fascinating insight into traditional Finnish life, culture, and heritage.

### **Day 07- Helsinki –**

After breakfast at the hotel enjoy Helsinki Highlights and Lapland Winter World, Helsinki

Enjoy Helsinki and Lapland wonders in 5 hours. Snow attractions and activities are available in any weather: igloos, ice bar, ice sculptures, sliding hill, kick-sledding, and fun skiing and happy time flies faster when you enter the Lappish world

We offer an unforgettable experience during your visit in Helsinki. We will cover all the top attractions of Helsinki and the unique Lapland Winter world. In the Winter World, you will feel the atmosphere of wintery Lapland. Lapland is an area above the Arctic Circle uniting Northern parts of Russian, Finland, Sweden and Norway. What makes Lapland so special is the original Sami people with their unique way of life, culture, and traditions that define the whole area.

The tour begins around 10:00 in the morning after we pick you up from your choice of designated hotel meeting points in Helsinki. The designed meeting points are close to many hotels and apartments with walking distance.

First, we visit the city's cultural landmarks and historic monuments. After seeing the highlights of Helsinki, we will drive to visit the Unique Lapland Winter world. This indoor winter park includes the world's only all-year-round Igloo hotel, a huge ice bar, restaurant and Husky sled drives. This is a really fun place where you will experience the wintertime. The temperature inside is -3~5 Celsius Degree, but don't worry as warm clothing is provided.
