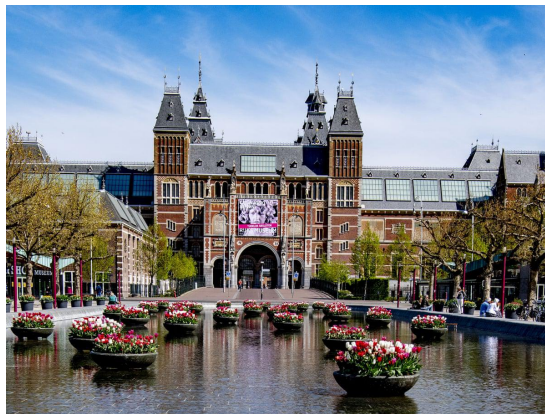

Day 01-Mumbai to Amsterdam-fter such a hectic journey Enjoy the evening with **Amsterdam City Canal Cruise, Amsterdam- 1h15m**

Day 03- After breakfast at the hotel visit Delft, The Hague & Madurodam Half-Day Tour from Amsterdam, Amsterdam-6 Hrs

Go beyond Amsterdam with a half-day tour of two important Dutch cities: Delft and The Hague. Admire the Netherlands' famous Delft blue-and-white pottery on a tour of the Royal Delft, followed by free time to explore Delft's historic city center. Then take a sightseeing tour of The Hague by coach, the seat of the Dutch Parliament, whose sights include the Parliament buildings, Noordeinde Palace and the Peace Palace, home to the International Court of Justice. Marvel at the miniature city of Madurodam. Your multilingual guide will provide insightful commentary throughout the afternoon.

Day 04 - Half-Day Tour to Volendam, Edam and the Windmills incl. 100 Highlights cruise-

Amsterdam Daily Bus Tour To Volendam, Edam and the Windmill Village. From the churning windmills in the Zaanse Schans to the cheese weighing house in Edam, this tour highlights everything typical Dutch. Including 100 Highlights Cruise, voucher is provided at the end of the tour.

Stop At: Stromma Netherlands, Amsterdam, North Holland Province

Enjoy the 100 Highlights Cruise through the beautiful canals of Amsterdam

Duration: 1 hour 10 minutes

Stop At: Zaanse Schans, Zaandam, North Holland Province

This outdoor conservation area is situated on the banks of the Zaan River and is home to traditional 18th and 19th century architecture, including several functioning windmills. Watch live demonstrations of craftsmen at work, including a clog maker crafting the famous wooden shoes of the Netherlands.

Duration: 1 hour

Stop At: Fort Edam, Edam, North Holland Province

From Zaandam, we'll continue on to Edam, also commonly referred to as the pearl of the Zuiderzee. Edam's ancient streets and tranquil canals are lined by beautiful 17th century buildings, including the leaning Carillon tower, the Great Church, and town hall. Most famous in Edam is beyond any doubt the public weighing house, where in summer still every Wednesday the famous Edam Cheese is being sold. After a stroll around this history-rich town, we'll have the opportunity to see how Edam's world-famous cheese is made and, of course, to taste it in a close by cheese farm.

Duration: 1 hour

Stop At: Volendam Haven, Volendam, North Holland Province

Finally, we will stop in the beautiful seaside village of Volendam. This typical fishing village with its bustling harbor has been a major tourist attraction as early as 1875. People come from all over to see the small buildings and houses and take in the locals in their traditional Dutch clothing. This is a great place to pick up souvenirs for those at home or a memento for yourself, and to have photos taken in traditional Dutch costume. Your guide will take you on a short walk through the oldest parts of the city, exploring a labyrinth of twists and turns to sites such as St. Vincent's Church, the wooden Stolphoevekerk and the Visafslag (Fish Auction).

Duration: 1 hour

Inclusion-Explore the historic windmills of Zaanse Schans, Stroll the twisting streets of Volendam and soak up the fishing village atmosphere, See the cheese weighing house in Edam, Watch traditional craftsmen at work, making clogs and other artifacts, Learn how Dutch cheese is being made in an old farm and taste the cheese, Including voucher for the 100 Highlights cruise, Entry/Admission - Stromma Netherlands, Entry/Admission - Zaanse Schans, Entry/Admission - Fort Edam, Entry/Admission - Volendam Haven

Day 5 – Amsterdam to Paris-

After breakfast check out from hotel and you will proceed for Paris by Train/Flight. Paris, France's capital, is a major European city and a global center for art, fashion, gastronomy and culture. On Arrival our driver will pick you up from airport and drop you at your selected hotel.

Later in the evening be ready for the amazing tour **At the Eiffel Tower, Seine River Cruise, and Dinner, Paris** Elevate your Eiffel Tower experience with a French dinner in a unique heated dome restaurant or enjoy a delicious etoile menu on a Seine river cruise boat. Don't waste your time lining up for Paris's most popular attraction, instead collect your skip-the-line ticket 15 minutes before your dinner reservation to head straight up to the restaurant. This original venue offers a unique experience surrounded by spectacular views across Paris. Savor the freshly served French cuisine in a traditional Parisian brasserie style. After your meal, spend some time soaking up the panoramic city views from the first and second floors and see if you can spot Paris' top monuments such as Montmartre and the Sacré Coeur, the Invalides, the Champ-de-Mars, the Champs Elysées and the Arc de Triomphe. Choose to finish your evening with an hour-long cruise along the Seine marveling at the architecture of Paris' illuminated monuments at the banks of the Seine.
