Kashmir



Day 01:- Arrival Srinagar airport 7km-

Arrival at Srinagar airport and transfer to Hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Srinagar.

Day 02:-Srinagar-Local sightseen-

After breakfast from hotel & proceed to Srinagar

Nishat Bagh is a terraced Mughal garden built on the eastern side of the Dal Lake, close to Srinagar in the state of Jammu and Kashmir, India. It is the second largest Mughal garden in the Kashmir Valley. The largest in size is the **Shalimar Bagh**, which is also located on the bank of the Dal Lake. 'Nishat Bagh' is Urdu, which means "Garden of Joy," "Garden of Gladness" and "Garden of Delight. Shalimar garden (abode of love) **Shalimar Bagh** is a Mughal garden in India, linked through a channel to the northeast of Dal Lake, on its right bank located near Srinagar city in Jammu and Kashmir. Its other names are Shalimar Garden, Shalimar Bagh, Farah Baksh and Faiz Baksh, and the other famous shore line garden in the vicinity is Nishat Bagh. The Bagh was built by Mughal Emperor Jahangir for his wife Nur Jahan, in 1619. The Bagh is considered the high point of Mughal horticulture. Chashmashahi (The royal spring). **Chashme Shahi** or **Chashma i Shahi** (translation: *the royal spring*), also called Chashma Shahi, is one of the Mughal gardens built in 1632 AD around a spring by Ali Mardan Khan, a governor of Mughal emperor Shah Jahan as per the orders of the Emperor, as a gift for his elder son Prince Dara Shikoh,.The garden is located in the Zabarwan Range, near Raj Bhawan (Governor's house) overlooking Dal Lake in Srinagar, Kashmir. and visit Shankra Acharya temple overnight stay at house boat in Srinagar.

Overnight stay at hotel in Srinagar.

Day 03:- Srinagar –Sonmarg-

After breakfast leave Hotel for full day tour of Sonamarg (Meadows of Gold), it has sheer scenic splendour. The very way-a metalled road snakes through massive mountains laden with forests and firs.

After a breath-taking journey from Srinagar you come across River Sindh that is abounded with trout & Mahseer. Onwards the valley opens up to a meadow. Ponies can be hired for a trip up to Thajiwas glacier; at own cost a major attraction during the summer months. Sonamarg's importance lies in the fact that it is the last halt on the Kashmir side for the drive from Srinagar to Leh. You will be fascinated to see Snowy Mountains against a cerulean sky against its backdrop return back Srinagar over night stay at Hotel in Srinagar

Day 04:- srinagar – Gulmarg-

After breakfast leave Hotel & proceed for full day excursion tour of Gulmarg "Meadow of Flowers". Gulmarg has a famous Golf course during summer (which is one of the highest 18-holes golf course in the world) & ski resort during winter. you can go for gondola (**cable car ride**) . over night stay at hotel in Srinagar .

Day 05:- Srinagar – Pahalgam-

After breakfast check –out from hotel & proceed to pahalgam ."VILLAGE OF SHEPHERDS " enroute visiting the world famous Saffron growing fields , Awantipura ruins (9th century) & Martand Temple (sun temple).Pahalgam is famous for indan film industry, some trekking routes & also base camp for Amarnath pilgrimage. You can also visit Chandan valley, betab valley, aru .**Betaab valley** is situated at a distance of 15 kilometers from Pahalgam in Anantnag district in India's northernmost state of Jammu and Kashmir. The valley got its name from the Sunny Deol-Amrita Singh hit debut film Betaab. The Valley is towards northeast of Pahalgam and falls between Pahalgam and Chandanwadi and is en route Amarnath Temple Yatra. The valley surrounded by lush green meadows, snow clad mountains and covered with dense vegetation **Chandanwari** is the starting point of the Amarnath Yatra, which takes place every year in the month of Sawan (Rain). It is famous for snow sledging on a snow bridge.Taxi cabs can be hired from Pahalgam for a roundtrip. The trip takes about four-five hours on a semi-road that has the Lidder river meandering on the one side, and lofty, snow-capped mountains on the other. 2/2

Some people prefer to do a day hike to Chandanwari. At Chandanwari, the Sheeshnag river is captivating with its sheer force and clear waters. You can get an opportunity to do sledge riding and get up to some heights, up to the fifth point which is also a route that yattris take to reach the Amarnath Cave. "Snow fights" is what people generally indulge in here before they sledge back down. Many prefer to sip a cup of tea of snack at the near by dhabas. Hajan, on the way to Chandanwari is an idyllic spot for a picnic.

Aru is a tourist spot in the Anantnag District of Jammu &Kashmir, India. It is located around 12 km from Pahalgam, . Noted for its scenic meadows, lakes and mountains, it is a base camp for trekking to the Kolhoi Glacier and Tarsar Lake. The village lies of the left bank of the Aru river, which is a tributary of the Lidder river.

Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 06:-PAHALGAM-KATRA-

Arrival at KATRA and transfer to Hotel katra.

Day 07:- KATRA-

meet on transfer to Helipad to catch the chopper for Shanjichat (Chopper ticket at your own cost) . From here will start trek to Mata Vaishno Devi shrine. After Darshan back to Shanjichat to catch the chopper for Katra.

Overnight stay at katra.

Day 8: KATRA - railway station –DEPARTURE

After breakfast check out from hotel & Proceed to rail way station / Srinagar airport for onward destination. Tour ends but sweet memories remain
