Daily itinerary:-

Day 1 –Mumbai- St.Petersburg – Fly for The St.Petersburg-

St. Petersburg is a Russian port city on the Baltic Sea. On arrival check in to the hotel. In the Evening enjoy Saint Petersburg River and Canal Boat Cruise- In a city of rivers and canals, drift along the waterways and see St. Petersburg from a different perspective on a leisurely boat cruise.

After Cruise ride visit Hermitage museum- The State Hermitage Museum in Saint Petersburg, second-largest art museum in the world. Its collections comprise over three million items, including the largest collection of paintings in the world. The collections occupy a large complex of six historic buildings along Palace Embankment, including the Main Museum Complex, General Staff Building, Winter Palace of Peter the Great, Menshikov Palace, the Museum of the Imperial Porcelain Factory

Overnight in St.Petersburg.

Day 2 – St.Petersburg -

After breakfast in the hotel enjoy City Sightseeing St Petersburg Hop-On Hop-Off Bus Tour.

Explore the key sights of St Petersburg on a 24 hour hop-on hop-off bus tour. The open-top deck allows passengers to enjoy panoramic views of the city, whilst also being able to hop on and off at

any of the 18 tour stops along the route! The tour covers the most iconic and popular landmarks, including St Isaac's Cathedral, Winter Palace, Kazan Cathedral, the Hermitage and many more!

Overnight in St.Petersburg.

Day 3 – St.Petersburg -

After breakfast at hotel enjoy Tour to Pavlovsk Palace and Park from St Petersburg.

Pavlovsk Palace and Park ensemble is included in the UNESCO World Heritage Site and is a mix of classy architecture and lovely landscape. Pavlovsk Palace has it all: fantasy, history, charm and a myriad of halls. Check out the Egyptian and the Front Hall, Italian Hall, Greek Hall, Cavaliers, Dance Halls, Big or Throne Room, Hall of Peace and Hall of War, the Art Gallery, the Library of Paul and other landmarks.

Don't skip the Peter and Paul Church in the Pavlovsk Palace (1799) and the monument to Paul I (1872) in front of the facade of the palace - an imitation of the monument of Louis XIV in front of the Versailles.

Take in the scenery of the Pavlovsk park and notice how elegantly all architectural structures fit in the natural landscape. The collection of Russian bronze sculpture in the Park will certainly amaze you. Overnight in St.Petersburg.

Day 4 – St.Petersburg to Moscow-

After breakfast at the hotel move towards Moscow by train. Arrive at the Moscow , Welcome to MOSCOW. On arrival, we proceed towards the hotel. After Check in enjoy Moscow City Tour. Panoramic city tour with stops at the most famous sights: Red Square, Poklonnaya Hill, New Maiden Convent. We will walk down Tverskaya Street, see Manezhnaya square, Ohotny Riad, Bolshoy theatre (outside), Lubyanka square and Kropotkinskaya embankments, Savior Cathedral and GUM department store.

Day 5 –Moscow-

After breakfast in the hotel will proceed to visit Gingerbread Tula.

Tula is known as the birthplace of delicious gingerbread and the "samovar capital" of Russia. It is located 185 km from Moscow. It is a calm and quiet town with an ancient history - it is a year older than the capital (founded in 1146). Most of the excursion objects - temples and monasteries.

Tula is famous for its pleasant climate - mild winter and cool summer. Streets of the city - a real open-air museum. There are many old buildings of the XVIII-XIX centuries. Tourists come here to take a look at the Tula Kremlin - this is the oldest building in the city.

Evening Tula is no less beautiful. Charms backlit Kremlin, museums, the building of the Moscow railway station. They shine with soft lights at home on Lenin and Krasnoarmeysky avenues. It is worth looking at the lighted facades of the Philharmonic and the buildings of the Nobility Assembly.

Day 6 – Moscow-

After breakfast in the hotel visit Izmailovo kremlin And Flea Market Tour.

Amazing city within a city! This is a unique center of culture and entertainment, where everyone will find something for everyone – tours, master classes for Russian crafts, meal in restaurants and cafes, walking and shopping. Russian handicraft centre Izmaylovo is famous for its open air souvenir market. Izmailovo is one of the oldest parts of Moscow, where the second Romanov Tzar Alexey Mikhailovich had his summer residence. One of the main highlight of the tour is Izmailovo Kremlin where you will be presented a short story about its history with common features of Russian

architecture of the XVII century. The Vernisage at Izmailovo is a large, outdoor shopping market, full of all sorts of Russian souvenirs, crafts and other interesting things to buy, along with paintings, “flea market” items, rugs from central Asia, and a few places to get a bite to eat or a drink. You can easily spend the better part of a day just wandering around among the stalls looking and buying.

Overnight in Moscow

Day 7 – Moscow to Mumbai -

After breakfast check out from hotel, our car will drop you at the airport. Board a flight for hometown with lots of good memories.
